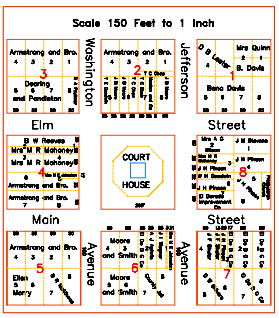
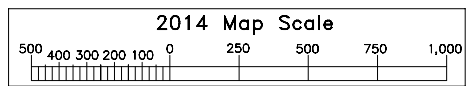


MAP

Variation
The Magnetic Variation for the vicinity of El Dorado for 1896 is 7° 00' East. The local variation of East and West lines is 0° 24' less or 8° 36'.

Latitude and Longitude
The Center of the Court House in El Dorado is in Latitude 33° 12' 00" and Longitude 92° 36' 00" West of Greenwich. The Capital Building at Washington [head of the statue of Liberty] is in Latitude 38° 53' 23".247 and Longitude 77° 00' 33".545 West of Greenwich. Difference in Longitude are 15° 35' 27".455.

Time 1 hour .02 minutes 22.8 Seconds.

Explanatory.
Where both red and black lines are used in the blocking of streets, the red will indicate the proper Building Line. Where no red is used the black line [representing either fence or building] is the correct Building Line.

The Red figures refer to the numbers of blocks used on the original plot of El Dorado.
